■ **Emotional support**

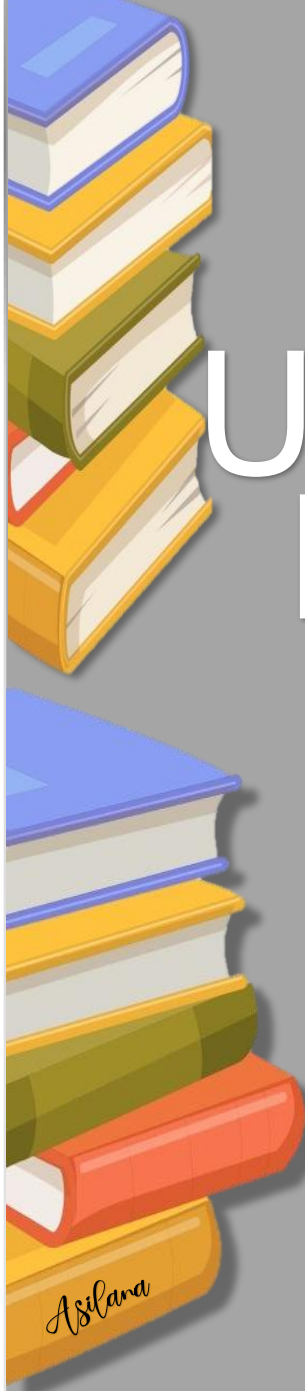
